## Parents Legal Centre materials **new**

The **Parents Legal Centre (PLC)** focuses on helping parents resolve their child protection matters early and collaboratively. It offers a lawyer and advocate to help at any stage of the child protection matter, from the first contact with the Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCF) or a delegated Aboriginal agency until it's apparent the matter can't be resolved through collaborative processes.

The first PLC opened in 2015 in Vancouver. There are now nine locations to serve communities across BC.
