
NOTING UP: METHOD 1



SCENARIO


How do I find BC Court of Appeal cases that have cited Section 147 of the Family Law Act?

Use the Note Up Field




COMMENTARY: Using the Note Up field will allow us to limit our search results to documents that cite the Family Law Act.

Filter by Section




COMMENTARY: Choosing Section 147 will allow us to filter our search results to only include documents that have cited this particular section of the Family Law Act.

Filter by Jurisdiction



COMMENTARY: As we are only interested in seeing British Columbia court decisions we need to click on All Jurisdictions and select British Columbia.

Filter by Document Type




COMMENTARY: Clicking on the Cases tab will limit our search results to include BC court cases only.

Filter by Court Level




COMMENTARY: Clicking on the All Courts and Tribunals tab will allow us to filter our search results by a specific court or tribunal. For our purposes we will click on Select Specific Courts and Tribunals in order to find the Court of Appeal for British Columbia.

Filter by Relevance



COMMENTARY: There are many sorting options. In this example we will choose Sort by Most Cited.
