PCWG description & purpose

The [Parenting Coordinators Working Group](#) consists of a private forum for parenting coordinators to share information and ask questions. The PCWG's FLO Working Group Page (as defined in the [FLO Community Terms of Use](#)) is an area of the Platform reserved exclusively for PCWG members (who are also members of FLO). PCSWG membership is restricted, and confidentiality among those who participate in the PCWG's private forum is expressly required.

Membership in PCWG

Who can join the PCWG

The PCWG is restricted to persons who may act as a parenting coordinator under the *Family Law Act Regulation*, BC Reg 347/2012 ("*FLA Reg*", [see s. 6](#)). Members of the [BC Parenting Coordinators Roster Society](#), those accredited by the Law Society of BC as parenting coordinators, and those who are not Law Society of BC members but satisfy the requirements of the *FLA Reg* can apply to join and must complete an acknowledgement of these guidelines and their confidentiality duties ([complete form online](#) or see [PCWG Application Certification](#) attached).

Confidentiality

Duty to keep PCWG content confidential

To ensure that the PCWG members will share Content responsibly and participate freely in members-only discussions, all Users who are granted access to the PCWG Working Group Page shall:

- before asking a question relating to a particular file, determine whether the lawyers for the parties in that file are members of the PCWG
- not forward or otherwise distribute Content unless expressly permitted by the Content owner to anyone,

including FLO Members, who is not a PCWG member.

Duty to keep client information and identities confidential

- Users are explicitly reminded of the [Universal Terms of Use](#)
- Users shall not post Content that divulges confidential client information or engage in communications about the affairs of a client that may reveal the client's identity even though the client is not named
